3.2.1. The institution has created an ecosystem for innovations and has initiatives for the creation and transfer of knowledge

Staff and students at our institution are encouraged to pursue research. Each year, our teachers publish their research articles in books with ISBNs, edit them, and publish their own books. They also publish their research papers in reputable journals. To a certain degree, our institution supports its employees.

Four of the institution's teachers—Drs. Anil Kumar Singh, S.G. Sagar, Gautam G. Sonwane, and Santosh L. Gaikwad—have been designated as research guides. Seven research researchers are conducting studies under the direction of Dr. Anil Kumar Singh, and one is being guided by Dr. Gautam G. Sonwane. For the M.Phil. and Ph.D. Viva Voce, Dr. Anil Kumar Singh has been called an external referee.

The College operates a Hindi Research centre under the direction of Dr. Anil Kumar Singh, Head of the Hindi Department in the isolated and tribal region of Thane Distrtict. It is the only center of its kind. A course on Historical Research & Sources is organized by the Department of History, while a course on Research Methodology in Economics is organized by the Department of Economics. Additionally, seminars and workshops are held for research work, soft skills, and career counseling for teachers and students.

Activities such as elocution competitions, quiz contests, and essay competitions are organized by the departments of English and B.sc. IT to foster students' creativity and entrepreneurial skills.

Every course at the postgraduate level includes a particular section on research project proposals, and our Staff guide to PG students on research projects. A college magazine that showcases students' artistic abilities and includes staff contributions gives them a platform to express their expertise and gives them access to a large student body.

The library is essential to the process of teaching and learning. Given that students and research students in remote locations like Shahapur should be encouraged to read, the college has a total of 50000+ books as well as 42 journals and publications. For general readers who want to study for competitive tests, the college includes a special collection of books on the subject. The library's resources include audio and video CDs, newspapers and journals, maps, online e-journals, and periodicals. Both boys' and girls' study areas are large and adjacent. To help them with their studies, the library has a special reading area for educators and researchers. The researchers have access to reference books and theses.

The library offers Internet access to its faculty, students, research scholars, and instructors. SC/ST students receive sets of textbooks for a school year through the Book-Bank Scheme. Every department has a departmental library that has been shown to be beneficial to students in addition to the main college library. LCD projectors, laptops, audio-visual presentations, Internet, and Wi-Fi facilities for students, instructors, and administrative tasks are just a few of the ICT tools our college has made available for the teaching and learning process. Additionally, our library offers online e-resources (e-books and e-journals) to students, instructors, and research scholars. Periodically, our college offers staff members an ICT awareness program.
