IQAC Annual Report 2018-19

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell of our college functions as per the guidelines of NAAC. It has become an important agency through which all the activities of the college are organized to sustain the quality. The meetings of IQAC are regularly held to check the working and progress of the action plan. The IQAC meetings were held on 17th July, 2018 and 5th October, 2018 and 27th March, 2019.

Prof. M. V. Navdhare suggested that the oldest part of the building was in a dilapidated condition which was hazardous and therefore it should be abandoned for the use to prevent any unwanted incident. The management immediately took the decision to abandon the building for the use. They also shifted the office of the Self- Financing Courses and some class-rooms temporarily to the building of the Women's Hostel. Necessary facilities were also provided in the building for the better functioning.

A meeting was organized between the Executive and Trustee Committee of the college and the staff in which the results of TY and PG classes were reviewed. They also discussed various issues related to the smooth functioning of the college. The members of the Executive and Trustee committee offered their valuable guidance to the staff about the quality work.

The AQARs of the years 2012-13 to 2017-18 were kept ready to be submitted to NAAC. Dr. S. G. Sagar suggested that the weather shed should be erected on the building of the Women's Hostel to prevent the leakage and to lengthen the life of the building. It was accepted by the management and also started the work of the weather shed.

Various seminars and workshops were organized for the students as well as staff to update their knowledge and enhance the research culture. The teaching faculty attended various conferences, workshops and seminars and presented their research papers. They also published their research papers in the journals recognized by UGC. Many of our teachers are pursuing their research in the field of their interest.


On the occasion of centenary Birth Anniversary of famous Marathi author P. L. Deshpande, famous Marathi poet, G. D.
