The meetings of IQAC are regularly held to check the working and progress of the action plan. The IQAC meetings were held on 28th June, 2014 and 15th November, 2014.

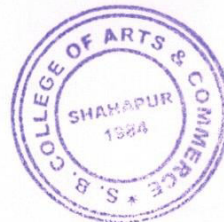
